Jersey Music Service Trumpet Project

Your child will be taking part in an exciting music project next term, receiving specialist Trumpet tuition from Jersey Music Service. The project will take place weekly for a period of 10 weeks. Every child taking part will be allocated an instrument for the project and will be permitted to take their instrument home to practise after the second session.

Your support in helping your child to remember their instrument every week and encouraging them to practise at home in between sessions will ensure that the project runs smoothly and effectively.

Throughout the project the children will develop a broad range of musical skills, introducing and developing universal musical concepts such as pulse, rhythm, pitch, dynamics, and ensemble skills.

At the end of the project, all parents are invited to attend a concert, where the children will demonstrate what they have learnt. This will occur in week 10 of the project during project teaching time. Confirmation of the concert will be confirmed at a later date.

After the concert the instruments will be returned to Jersey Music Service for use in future projects and it is therefore essential that the trumpet loaned to your child is looked after carefully and returned in the same condition as it was received. Damage to instruments will be charged at between £20 and £50 and a replacement mouthpiece is £25.
