Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> & Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> June at the Royal Jersey Showground, Trinity

Open from 10.30am to 5pm both days – Adults £5, Senior Citizens £3, Children and Members free

Early Summer Flower Show: Includes lots of beautiful displays of pot plants, cut flowers, fruit, vegetables, cakes, and flower arranging. The Cake Auction will be held at 3.30pm on Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> June with all proceeds going to the JSPCA Animals' Shelter and the prize giving will follow the auction at approximately 4.15pm on Sunday.

Cattle Show: Saturday In Milk classes and Sunday Heifer classes commencing 11am both days.

Discover Dairy: This year we will have a marquee called 'Discover Dairy' dedicated to promoting the dairy industry with lots of fun activities for the children.

Jersey Dairy will be selling ice-creams, Beresford Street Kitchen will be providing good and drinks and Blanc Pignon Dairy Farm will be serving wraps and coffee.
