We are now coming to the end of a very busy term and we would like to thank you for all of your help and support, particularly during Technology week and the Eisteddfod.

The boys have worked exceptionally hard this term in the build up to the Entrance Exam and we have been very impressed with their attitude and application. Thank you for the support and encouragement you have given them during this period.

On a lighter note, since the exam we have enjoyed the inaugural Silver Dodgeball competition. This was a keenly contested event with as much noise and energy from the sidelines as on the court of play itself! 6H and 6J were tied after the 12 rounds and went into a playoff, 6H ending up winners 10 – 5!
