



GCSE Results' Day – Thursday 24th August 2023

Examination Results

GCSE results will be available for students to collect from the Great Hall on **Thursday 24th August 2023 between the hours of 09:00am and 12.00 noon.**

If alternative arrangements for the collection of results are required, Mr. Falle and Ms Croft will need to be notified in advance in writing (by email) and, if someone is collecting them on your family's behalf, the nominated proxy will need to bring proof of identity.

Where students have been offered a conditional place in our Sixth Form and have met the general and subject specific entrance requirements, they will only need to confirm their intentions to Mrs Job on Results' Day.

Where a student needs to reconsider his option choices in the light of his results, he will need to seek advice from College; key staff will be here on **Thursday 24th August 2023 from 09.00 until 17:00** and **Friday 25th August between 08.00 until 12:00**, or by appointment the following week.

All students must have confirmed their courses by **12.30 on Wednesday 30th August 2023**, at the latest.

If your son is taking a subject at another Sixth Form institution please note that there will be induction sessions for him on **5th September 2023**, as follows :

Appeals

If you would like a Marking Review of your GCSE level papers:

Marking Review Request Forms will only be available from the Exams Office and on the school website at the beginning of the Autumn Term. The deadline for submission of Reviews of Marking requests to the exam boards is Thursday 28th September 2023. Fees vary by exam board, details available on results day and on the website.

Heads of Department will inform students who are close to a grade boundary.

It is important to realise that marks and grades are not always raised as a result of a marking review; they can simply be confirmed and may even be lowered. There will be no charge if

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either the unit grade(s) or the overall grade is raised and, should that be the case, your payment will be refunded. (If the marks increase but the original grade is unchanged, the original mark is confirmed, or the mark/grade lowered, the fees paid will not be returned to you as the College will be charged for the service.)

Occasionally, the Head of Department will ask for a number of scripts to be reviewed. This is a rare occurrence, but if a department does make such a request, you will be asked to sign a consent form giving your permission.
