VICTORIA COLLEGE – UCAS QUALIFICATIONS STATEMENT

Victoria College is a Government of Jersey school, serving students across the 11-18 age range. Funding is part covered by the Government and part by parental fees. The Victoria College Foundation (established 2002), funded through Foundation Partners (local businesses) and broader fundraising work, provides means tested bursary support for those families below household income thresholds.

Students follow a traditional Sixth Form curriculum, studying at least 3 A levels or equivalent subjects. Predicted grades are based on evidence of performance in Year 12 and 13, coupled with the professional judgement of subject teachers.

The College operates a collaborative relationship with three other sixth form providers on Island, which allows for a broader academic provision, to include subjects not taught within our own curriculum, including vocational options such as CTEC Business.

As part of our enrichment programme some students study additional UCAS qualifying courses such as AS Photography and LAMDA. These courses are allocated significantly less time than the guided teaching hours.
